7:30 Arrival and transfer to Tikal National Park to visit the archaeological site. Tikal means “place of voices”. It is the largest ever known and studied Maya city. The park covers an area of 576 square meters. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1979.

Visit the Island of Flores

It is located on Lake Peten Itza, which is the second largest in Guatemala. Nearby is the Natural Park and zoo Petencito and King Kanek Mirador.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2nd ANTIGUA GUATEMALA-CHICHICASTENANGO-ATITLAN LAKE

La Antigua Guatemala city tour. It is the main icon of colonial Spanish heritage. It is located in the valley of Panchoy, surrounded by three volcanoes and mountains with coffee plantations. For its history and beauty was declared "Cultural Heritage of Humanity" by UNESCO in 1979. With its incomparable buildings and ancient cobbled streets, is a scenario in which charge splendid cultural and religious life. The city exudes romance on every corner, it is the ideal place to hold weddings and special events stage. Visitors can choose from beautiful colonial hotels, both type hotels "boutique" hotels as "charming", with first class facilities for conferences and business meetings in an inspiring environment.

Lunch at Chichicastenango

Chichicastenango is the center of town and the commercial life of the "Maxeños" (adjective that is given to the people of Chichicastenango, derived from Max, which means Thomas in Quiché language). Traders come down on Thursdays and Sundays, to the central square to sell their wares in a stunning indigenous market, which has changed little over the centuries. Visit the Church of St. Thomas built in 1540 on remains of a pre-Hispanic temple, represents a fine example of colonial architecture. Outside and inside indigenous and Ladino rites are mixed.

At the end of the tour, transfer to Panajachel for dinner and lodging

FRIDAY OCTOBER 3rd PANAJACHEL – CIUDAD CAPITAL

08:00 Transfer by boat to visit Lake Atitlan.

It is considered one of the most beautiful in the world by the famous writer Aldous Huxley and is undoubtedly the most important natural attraction and one of the best known of Guatemala. Three spectacular volcanoes, Toliman, Atitlan and San Pedro, form the natural setting of the lake. It has an area of 125 square kilometers and is located 1,560 meters above sea level. The lake with scenic beauty complements its roads, beaches and coastal villages, mountains and volcanoes.

It offers excellent opportunities to develop sport fishing, sailing, cayaks, gliding, water skiing and recreation naturalist and visit the Mayan peoples of the area. Surrounding lake Atitlán, you will find towns with biblical names: Santa Catarina Palopó, San Antonio Palopó, San Lucas Tolimán, Santiago Atitlán, San Pedro La Laguna, San Juan La Laguna, San Pablo La Laguna, San Marcos La Laguna, Santa Cruz La Laguna, Panajachel and others one.
